

## Rules for students regarding safety at work and fire protection

According to the Labour Code, the Employer must ensure health and safety of employees at work regarding the life and health risk at work.

The Employer's duty to ensure health and safety at work shall apply to all people who stay at the Employer's workplaces with the knowledge of the Employer.

Since individual workplaces at the Institutes have their own specific features and particularities, students will be informed of the safety rules and regulations for the given conditions before the seminars and work in laboratories and workshops. Students are obliged to follow the rules, standards and regulations and superior staff's instructions, and to participate in training arranged by the Faculty aimed at health and safety protection at work including testing of their knowledge. They must report shortcomings and defects immediately to their pedagogical staff.

In case of occupational injury during the instruction or work for the Institute, students are obliged to report it immediately to the supervising pedagogical staff.

The injured person, if his/her state of health permits, or another person that has witnessed the injury, is obliged to report the occupational injury immediately to the pedagogical staff. In case of injury occurred during instruction, Bursar's directive No. 1/2008, as amended, shall be applied. In case of student's injury occurred when working for the Institute under the Work Agreement, Rector's directive No. 17/2008 shall be applied. The Institute is not obliged to compensate the student for his/her injury if it was caused by student's own negligence, intentionally, or under the influence of alcohol or other addictive substances.

When using lifts, students must follow the instructions for the given lift.

In classrooms, laboratories, and workshops, where the desks are fitted with sockets, students can use this equipment only with the teaching staff's agreement.

Students must not enter the BUT premises under the influence of alcohol or other addictive substances, or smoke there.

In accordance with Act No. 133/1985 Coll., on fire protection, as subsequently amended, students are obliged to act in such a way that fire cannot break out. If any fire defects are found in the BUT premises, the students must report the defects to their pedagogical staff or, if the staff is not available, at the reception. In case of fire, students must take all measures to extinguish fire quickly (by using fire extinguishers at corridors), or call the fire brigade. Fires shall be reported at the reception with non-stop service. Students are obliged to make themselves familiar with directives and rules concerning fire protection, as well as graphical charts of the evacuation plan for Institutes that are located at visible places in corridors.

Portable fire extinguishers are located at visible and readily accessible places, and always in corridors.

**Students have been informed about extraordinary situation connected with the reconstruction of the building A1. When moving in the building A1, students should use only the marked corridors and protected passageways, and take special care during the reconstruction. Access to the construction site is prohibited.**
